

KAMAP Confidentiality Agreement

- When sharing cases, patient details and identifying information will be removed to protect confidentiality
- The practitioner is responsible for gaining the patient's consent to share for educational and support/advice purposes
- In the spirit of collaboration and in the interest of learning, the practitioner will gain patient consent (see the template consent form provided), so that cases can be shared for advice/support/educational purposes. All communication that includes sensitive patient information must confirm consent to share has been gained (in writing)
- Cases shared within membership resources must not be reposted or copied outside of KAMAP without the written permission of the practitioner and their patient
- Members will not use the name of KAMAP, its officers or members, or its intellectual property, publications or promotional materials without express written permission
